English class with either Richards or Bright, see Mrs. Bussman to determine when you will complete the Cassville General Scholarship Application. The application will be due in the Guidance Office by March 28. Before we meet create a résumé of your activities, awards, and work experience, and write a short paragraph about your future plans. Cassville scholarship recipients may use the funds at any technical school (example: Tulsa Welding, Neosho Beauty College) or two or four-year colleges in or out of Missouri (example: Crowder, Northwest AR Community College, William Woods University). The application will be completed for a CA grade from your teacher, and for copies to be distributed from the Guidance Office to all local scholarship donors. Local businesses and community members have been very generous. Remember, you will be competing for these scholarships with only CHS class members who complete the application for distribution, instead of students state or nation-wide. You have 140 class members – what are the odds of you taking home a scholarship if three fourths of the class applies? Do the math. If you do not apply, your odds will be **0/140**. **Don't ever assume that you won't be able to get one of these scholarships!**

There is still a scholarship available for a student from Cassville who plans to attend NEO in Miama, OK. NEO does NOT charge Cassville students out of state tuition.

Make use of Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday to search for scholarships, complete the FAFSA, work on a résumé, and complete applications for college entrance and scholarships! www.studentscholarships is a VERY good scholarship site.

Seniors, if you are unsure of how to complete the FAFSA, there will be help at SRTC (vo-tech) in Monett on March 5, from 6:00-8:00. Bring your parent's/guardian's 2012 tax information and with personal assistance complete your FAFSA in less than an hour. See the posters throughout the building for information and other locations and times. This is a come when you can, and leave when you finish, 6-8:00 event.

Seniors, help yourself out by studying for and passing the constitution test(s) you have not passed as of yet. If you have lost yours, study guides are in the guidance office. You will not graduate nor participate in the graduation ceremonies if you have not passed both the US and the MO constitution tests!
