Summer Lifeguards Needed!!! The Cassville YMCA is currently accepting applications until **Monday, March 25th** for lifeguards for the upcoming 2013 season. They are looking for enthusiastic individuals with a positive and respectful attitude towards children and adults. Applicants must be 16 before May 26th and be proficient in swimming. Red Cross lifeguard and CPR/First Aide training and certification will be offered to all applicants. Starting pay will be \$7.35/hr with an average of 20-30 hours scheduled per week. Applications can be picked up in the counselor's office or at the YMCA.

Seniors: The Cassville High School Alumni Association Scholarship is now available in the counselor's office. To be considered eligible you must be a relative of a previous CHS graduate. Applications must be submitted no later than **Friday, April 12th**.

There is a new scholarship list dated March 12th in the counselors' office.

The general and departmental scholarship deadline for MSU is **March 31st**.

Seniors, **be sure to check the website of your chosen college for Foundation Scholarships**. Every college offers these, and they often have requirements other than talent or grades. OTC has a Foundation Scholarship **called the Jarred Welch Memorial Scholarship that will be awarded to a Cassville student!** **You must apply to OTC before you can apply for the Welch scholarship – Do this today!!!**

The Cassville general Scholarship Application is due in the Guidance Office by **March 28**. **If you do not have an English class with either Richards or Bright, see Mrs. Bussman to determine when you will complete the Cassville General Scholarship Application.** Cassville scholarship recipients may use the funds at any technical school (example: Tulsa Welding, Neosho Beauty College) or two or four-year colleges in or out of Missouri (example: Crowder, Northwest AR Community College, William Woods University). The application will be completed for a CA grade from your teacher, and for copies to be distributed from the Guidance Office to all local scholarship donors. Local businesses and community members have been very generous. Remember, you will be competing for these scholarships with only CHS class members who complete the application for distribution, instead of students state or nation-wide. You have 140 class members – what are the odds of you taking home a scholarship if three fourths of the class applies? Do the math. If you do not apply, your odds will be **0/140**. **Don't ever assume that you won't be able to get one of these scholarships!**

There is still a scholarship available for a student from Cassville who plans to attend NEO in Miami, OK. NEO does NOT charge Cassville students out of state tuition.

www.studentscholarships is a **VERY good scholarship site.**

Seniors, help yourself out by studying for and passing the constitution test(s) you have not passed as of yet. Study guides are in the guidance office. You will not graduate nor participate in the graduation ceremonies if you have not passed both the US and the MO constitution tests!

Lunch & Student I.D.'s:

You must have a minimum of 3 items from the lunch line (one item may be milk). If you come through the line with less than 3 items you will be asked to go back. Extras do not count!
