Selective admissions. Early application encouraged. **All application materials and scholarship applications should be submitted by December 1.** \$35 application fee. Waivers available.

In-district tuition is \$214 p/hour. To be admitted you must have:

- A high school GPA of 2.50 or higher
- ACT composite score of 17 or higher
- English/Language Arts - 4 units
- Social Studies - 3 units
- Mathematics - 3 units, including Algebra II
- Science - 3 units
- Fine Arts - 1 unit
- Academic Electives - 3 units from the core, 2 credits of Foreign Language strongly recommended

Feb. 1, 2019

For priority consideration, submit your application by Feb. 1, 2019. Applications are accepted through April 1, 2019, at midnight CT.

Visit the school's website or contact its financial aid office. School deadlines are usually early in the year (often in February or March, although some are even earlier).

FEDERAL DEADLINE

June 30, 2020

The online FAFSA form must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. Central time (CT) on June 30, 2020. Any corrections or updates must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. CT on Sept. 12, 2020.

MAIN A+ SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS



- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Receive a 2.5 or higher GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Have a high school attendance record of at least 95 percent
- Tutor or mentor for at least 50 hours

Crowder College **Academic Scholarships** - Crowder College offers Academic, Departmental, Athletic, Performance and Foundation Scholarships intended to assist students and their families in meeting college expenses. Multiple scholarships may be awarded based on student need and eligibility requirements. A+ students are eligible for Academic Scholarships. Applications: Crowder.edu/financial-aid/scholarships

HONORS

Presidential Honors (Full tuition, fees and book loans)

- Must apply and be accepted to Crowder's Honors Program. Applications and eligibility information available at www.Crowder.edu/Academics/Honors
- Renewable for up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA, completion of at least 15 credit hours per semester and receive a "B" or above in all Honors coursework.
- Fall priority deadline is March 1

The following scholarships require a completed application be submitted online by April 1

Center Scholarship (\$775 per semester, fall & spring, toward tuition, fees and books)

- High school graduates who have a minimum 3.5 GPA & will attend the Center from which the scholarship is awarded
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester.
- Interested students may inquire at a Crowder Center
- Fall priority deadline is March 1

Trustees (\$675 per semester, fall & spring, applied to tuition and fees and books)

- High school seniors graduating from an accredited high school, ranking in the top 15% of their class OR a student scoring a 25 or higher on the ACT (includes high school and homeschool graduates.)
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Interested students may inquire at a Crowder Center
- Fall priority deadline is March 1

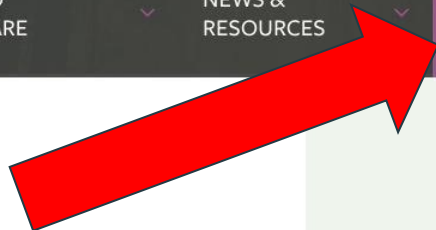

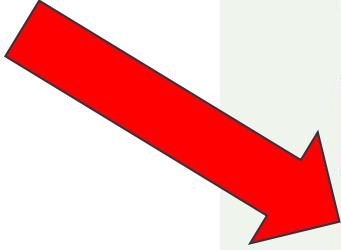


How to Apply

Beginning Feb. 1, click the link below to our online application portal to apply. You will first have to create a username and password to establish your account. Next, you will be prompted to answer a couple of eligibility questions to determine which scholarships you are eligible to apply for.

Each scholarship has its own criteria and application requirements. You will be able to apply for some scholarships directly through this website while others will require you to contact your counselor or other representative in order to obtain a hard-copy application.

Be sure to read the criteria for each scholarship carefully. Please note that a separate application will need to be submitted for each scholarship for which you are applying.


