Tell your parents who the characters are and describe them.</p> <p>*Walk outside in your yard, say the names of objects, and clap the syllables for that word.</p> <p>*Have your family member say a word, find the beginning sound of that word on our ABC chart (see chart below in the Title section for the chart).</p>	<p>*Write your last name 5 times</p> <p>*Practice writing upper and lowercase letters Xx and Yy.</p> <p>*Write your name and go on a letter hunt for each of those letters around your house (ex: look at signs, decorations, books, magnetic letters, whatever you have around your house).</p> <p>*Make a label or pattern book about flowers or gardens.</p>	<p>*Count the rocks in your yard and write the number.</p> <p>*Rainbow write the numbers 1 to 20. See last week's explanation of rainbow writing. if you do not have crayons use a pencil or pen and write 7 times.</p> <p>*Sort blocks/cars by color, size, and shape.</p> <p>*Go on a shape hunt around your house or outside and find all 5 shapes: circle, square, triangle, rectangle, hexagon. Say the names as you find them.</p>
