- Read a story to your child. Have him/her illustrate their favorite part.
- Write simple sight words on pieces of paper. Have your child draw pictures of a dog, cat, boy, and girl. Have your child make a sentence with the words and pictures.
- Practice rhyming words. Say a word and have your child say a word that rhymes. Do this ten times.
- Practice writing Upper and lower case letters in order. Example: Aa Bb Cc Dd Ee Ff Gg . . .

- Write a letter to your teacher or a classmate.
- Write a story about a special memory in kindergarten.
- Make a list of your most favorite things about kindergarten!
- Draw or write ALL the things you love!

- Use attached Earth Day paper to practice your subtraction skills.
- Find all the ways to make a number. For example I selected the number 7  $4+3=7$ ,  $1+6=7$ ,  $3+4=7$ ,  $0+7=7$ ,  $2+5=7$ ,  $5+2=7$ ,  $6+1=7$ ,  $7+0=7$
- Make 2D and 3D shapes with the items you find outside (sticks, rocks, grass, etc.)  
 Shapes: triangle, square, circle, rectangle, hexagon, cone, cube, sphere, pyramid
