Indoor Obstacle Course-Use items from around the house such as pillows, balls, a broom, tissues, chairs, etc. to create an indoor obstacle course. Have your child move from obstacle to obstacle doing different movements-slithering like a snake, carrying a cotton ball on a spoon, or crab walking. You can also create mini challenges, like jumping over a piece of tape 5 times or hopping on one foot 3 times and hopping on the other foot 6 times.
