

Cassville R-IV School District is currently operating at an Engagement Level 2 according to our Return to Learn and ReEntry Plan. If you plan to send a Valentine gift to school, please note the following guidelines.

1. Gifts for primary, intermediate and middle school students must be dropped off at the FEMA

- Event Center.
- 2. Gifts for high school students must be dropped off at the FEMA building located at the northend of the high school campus.

Drop-offs will only be accepted on Thursday, February 11 during the following time slots:

<u>9-11 a.m.</u>: local business drop-off time

<u>11-12:30 p.m.</u>: parents, grandparents and families drop off time

<u>12:30-1:30 p.m.</u>: final local business drop off time

<u>1:30 p.m.</u>: FEMA buildings will be locked and no additional drop-offs will be accepted.

3. Students and staff will pick-up their gifts at the end of the day. Gifts will not be taken back to their classrooms. If an item is not picked up, it will be returned to the local business that made the delivery.
