

What is Title 1?

Title 1 is a program through which school districts may receive federal funding to provide supplemental instruction for students who qualify. The funds for each school district are based on a state formula that is calculated based on the number of students from economically disadvantaged homes. However, federally funded Title 1 services are based on the academic needs of students. The goal of the Title 1 program is to increase student performance and academic achievement.

Parent Notification

Parents of eligible students will be notified about the program details in early fall or throughout the school year. Additionally, parents will receive notices and information throughout the school year to keep you informed about the progress of your child.

Literacy Under the Lights: Oct. 6th 5:00-6:30 p.m.


